Abstract submission for oral presentations and posters

Please, submit in the same text box a short abstract of max 200 words with the headline of **Short Abstract** followed by your extended abstract of max. 800 words, with the headline of **Extended abstract**, and 5 key words, before 18th March 2024, via the conference website. Preliminary research should be submitted for the poster session.

Please indicate if you prefer to do an oral presentation or a poster.

Abstract submission for thematic sessions

We invite groups of researchers to propose a theme for special sessions.

Your submission requires the following in one document before 18th March 2024:

- a proposed topic
- a short overview
- list of all presenters names and institutes
- title for each presentation
- short abstract of max 200 words followed by the extended abstract of max. 800 words

certificate, and will be listed in the associations' newsletters. A committee of SABE/IAREP members will evaluate the submitted papers.

The criteria are:

- (a) the interest of the paper topic for economic psychology and/or behavioral economics;
- (b) quality of research;
- (c) quality of writing;
- (d) contribution of the student to the paper (the student has to be the first/ corresponding author, and their presentation has to be accepted for the conference)
